# Harvest Roosters

Please read all instructions carefully before starting. All instructions include a 1/4" seam allowance and strips are cut from selvage to selvage unless otherwise stated.

## Table Runner Instructions: approximate size 18" x 72"

### 1. Cut the following:

**Fabric A** - cut 2 borders lengthwise - 3 1/2" x 18 1/2"  
(pumpkins)

cut 2 borders lengthwise - 3" x 18 1/2" (leaves for backing)

**Fabric B** - cut 1 - 9 1/4" strip, subcut 4 - 9 1/4" squares, cut in half diagonally from both directions for 16 triangles ☒

**Fabric C** - BACKING - cut 1 - 18 1/2" x 67 1/2"

**Fabric D** - cut 1 - 9 1/4" strip, subcut 4 - 9 1/4" squares, cut in half diagonally from both directions for 16 triangles ☒

**Fabric E** - cut 1 - 2 1/2" strip, subcut 16 - 2 1/2" squares

**Fabric F** - cut 3 - 2 1/2" strips. Use 1 strip and subcut 16 - 2 1/2" squares

**Fabric H** - cut 2 - 2 7/8" strips, subcut 16 - 2 7/8" squares, cut in half diagonally for 32 triangles ☒

**Border** - cut 5 - 1 1/2" strips, sew end to end for 1 long strip, then subcut 2 - 1 1/2" x 64 1/2" and 2 - 1 1/2" x 18 1/2"

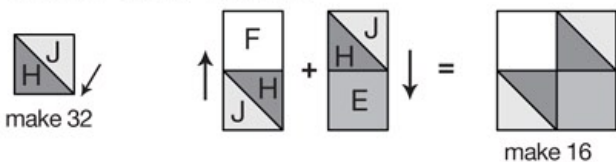
**Fabric I** - cut 2 - 2 1/2" strips

**Fabric J** - cut 2 - 2 7/8" strips, subcut 16 - 2 7/8" squares, cut in half diagonally for 32 triangles ☒

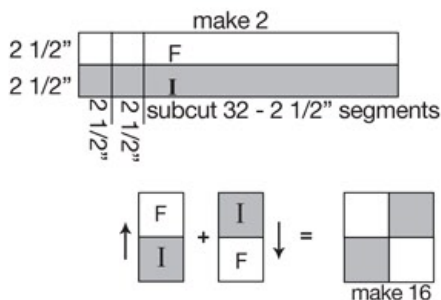
Thin Batting - cut 1 - 18 1/2" x 72 1/2"

### 2. Piecing Order:

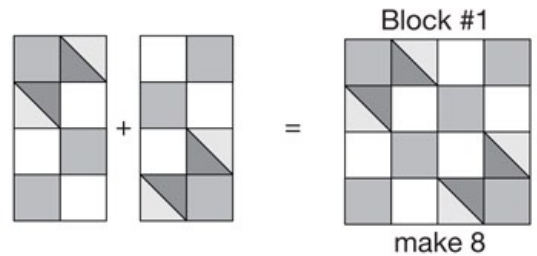
1. Make 8 - 8" finished (8 1/2" unfin.) Block #1. First, sew **J** and **H** triangles together for 32 units according to the diagram. Press toward **H**. Next, sew **J/H** units with **E** and **F** 2 1/2" squares together for 4-Patches. Press toward **E** and **F** squares.



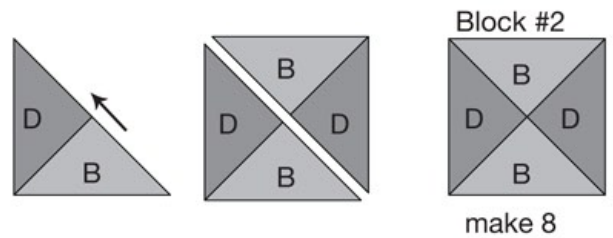
Next, make two strip sets by sewing **F** and **I** 2 1/2" strips side by side. Press toward **F**. Subcut 32 - 2 1/2" segments. Then, sew segments together for 16 4-Patches according to the diagram.



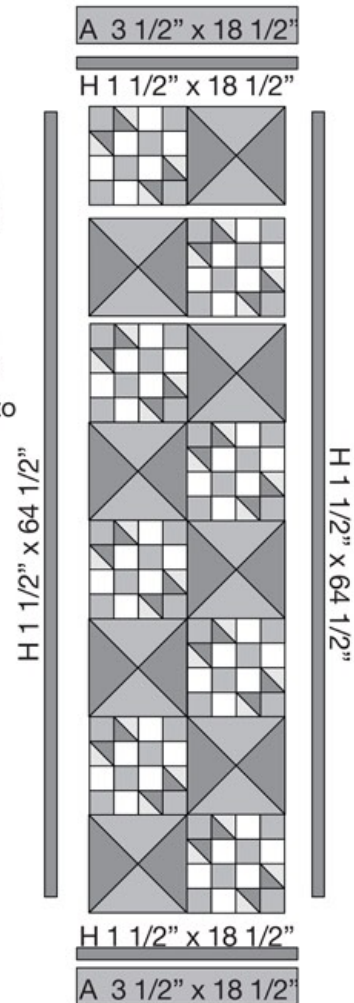
Next, sew 4-Patches together by rows according to the diagram.



2. Make 8 - 8" finished (8 1/2" unfin.) Block #2. First, sew 16 pairs of **B** and **D** triangles. Press toward **D**. Next, sew pairs together according to the diagram.

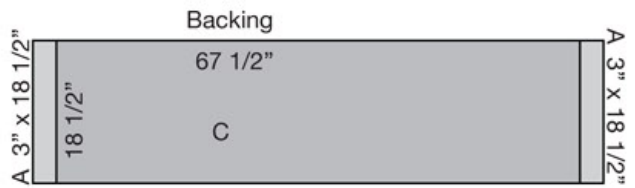


3. Sew rows alternating Blocks #1 and #2 according to the diagram. Next, sew **H** 1 1/2" border around Table Runner, SIDES first, then TOP and BOTTOM borders. Last, sew **A** 3 1/2" x 18 1/2" to the TOP and BOTTOM of the Table Runner according to the diagram.

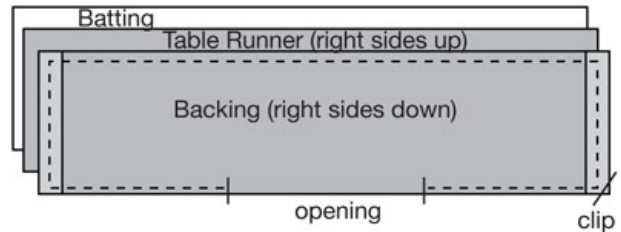


## Table Runner cont.

4. Make backing by sewing **A** 3" x 18 1/2" to both ends of **C** 18 1/2" x 67 1/2"



5. Layer in the following order: Batting, Table Runner (right sides up), Backing (right sides down). Match edges and pin layers together. Stitch 1/4" around table runner, leaving approximately 12" opening in the middle of one long side for turning. Clip corners. Turn table runner right sides out. Stitch opening closed. Quilt as desired. Enjoy!!



## Placemat Instructions (Set of Four) approximate size 12" x 18 1/2"

1. **Cut the following:**

**Fabric A** - cut 4 individual rectangles lengthwise - 7" x 13 1/2" (center designs evenly)

**Fabric C** - BACKING - cut 4 - 12 1/2" x 19"

**Fabric G** - cut 6 - 1 1/2" strips, subcut 8 - 1 1/2" x 7" and 8 - 1 1/2" x 15 1/2"

**Fabric H** - cut 6 - 2 1/4" strips, subcut 8 - 2 1/4" x 9" and 8 - 2 1/4" x 19"

Thin **BATTING** - cut 4 - 12 1/2" x 19"

2. **Piecing Order:**

1. Sew **G** border around **A** centers, **SIDES** first, then **TOP** and **BOTTOM** borders according to the diagram below.

2. Next, sew **H** borders around placemats, **SIDES** first, then **TOP** and **BOTTOM** borders.

3. Layer the following in order as listed: Batting, Placemat (right sides up), Backing (right sides down). Match edges and pin layers together. Stitch 1/4" around edge of placemat, leaving approximately 6" opening for turning on one long side. Clip corners then turn placemat right sides out. Stitch opening closed. Quilt as desired. Enjoy!!
