# VROOM! VROOM!



Please read all instructions carefully before starting. All instructions include a 1/4" seam allowance and strips are cut from selvage to selvage unless otherwise stated.

## Quilt Instructions:

Approximate size 69" x 93"

### 1. Cut the following:

**Fabric C** - cut 1 - 12 1/2" strip, subcut 3 - 12 1/2" squares

**Fabric D** - cut 1 - 6 7/8" strip, subcut 4 - 6 7/8" squares, cut 2 squares in half diagonally  and cut 2 squares in half diagonally 

cut 2 - 2" x 12 1/2"

cut 1 - 11 7/8" strip, subcut 4 - 11 7/8" x 6 7/8"

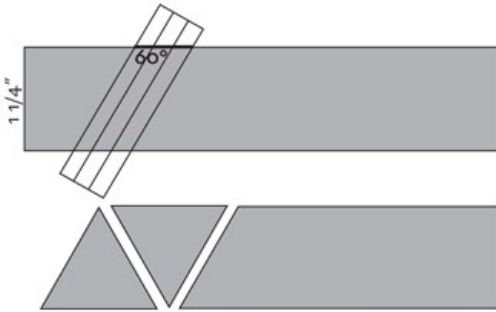
rectangles, cut rectangles in half diagonally according to the diagrams (directional fabric so use only triangles next to \*)



**Fabric F** - cut 3 - 12 1/2" strips, subcut 8 - 12 1/2" squares

**Fabric G** - cut 6 - 2 1/2" strips, sew strips end to end for one long strip, then subcut: 2 - 2 1/2" x 62 1/2" (SIDES) and 2 - 2 1/2" x 42 1/2" (TOP and BOTTOM)

**Fabric I** - cut 1 - 11 1/4" strip. Place 60° line of ruler over top raw edge, cut left side of triangle, next place 60° line of ruler over bottom raw edge lining up ruler with top edge of previously cut angle. Cut two 60° triangles.



**Fabric J** - cut 19 - 2 1/2" strips (pair with O, N and L strips)

cut 6 - 2 1/2" strips, sew end to end for one long strip, then subcut: 2 - 2 1/2" x 68 1/2" (SIDES) and 2 - 2 1/2" x 48 1/2" (TOP and BOTTOM)

**Fabric K** - cut 2 - 9" x 9" squares

**Fabric L** - cut 5 - 2 1/2" strips

**Fabric M** - cut 5 - 2 1/2" strips, subcut 68 - 2 1/2" squares

**Fabric N** - cut 9 - 2 1/2" strips

cut 2 - 3 1/2" strips, subcut 12 - 3 1/2" squares

cut 11 - 1 1/2" strips, sew end to end for one long strip, then subcut 1st border - 2 - 1 1/2" x 60 1/2" (Sides) and 2 - 1 1/2" x 38 1/2" (Top and Bottom); 2nd Border - 2 - 1 1/2" x 66 1/2" (Sides) and 2 - 1 1/2" x 44 1/2" (Top and Bottom)

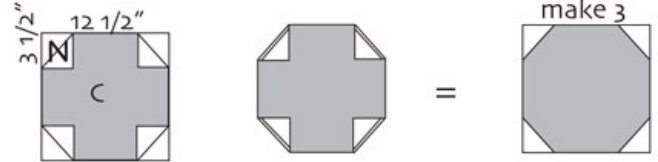
**Fabric O** - cut 5 - 2 1/2" strips

**Fabric P** - cut 5 - 2 1/2" strips, subcut 68 - 2 1/2" squares

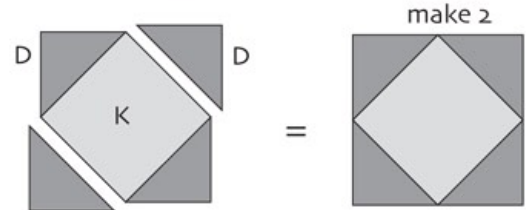
**BINDING** - cut 9 - 2 1/4" strips, sew end to end and press in half.

### 2. Piecing Order:

1. Draw a diagonal line on the backside of 12 N 3 1/2" squares. Place one N square over each corner of 3 C 12 1/2" squares, right sides together. Stitch ON the diagonal line, trim 1/4" from seam. Press triangle outward.



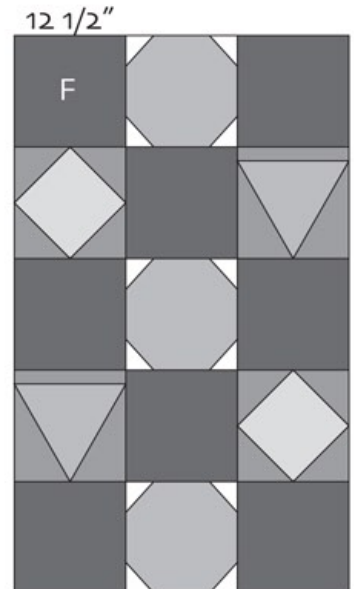
2. Sew D 6 7/8" triangles to all sides of 2 K 9" squares, opposite sides first. Pay attention to correct placement of directional triangles and center triangles evenly.



3. Sew D triangles to two sides of I 60 triangles. Pay attention to directional triangle placement. Next, sew D 2" x 12 1/2" strip to the top. Make 2 - 12" finished blocks (12 1/2" unf.)



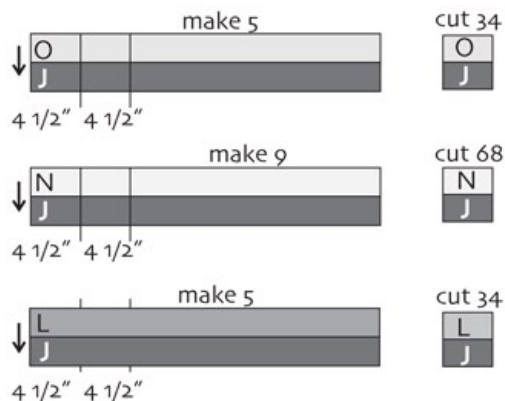
4. Sew rows of blocks, then sew rows together according to the diagram.



5. Sew individual **N**, **G**, **N** and **J** borders to the quilt, **SIDES** first, then **TOP** and **BOTTOM** borders according to the diagram. Press each border before sewing the next one.

6. Border Blocks: Make 18 - 8" finished (8 1/2" unf.) Block #1. Make 16 - 8" finished (8 1/2" unf.) Block #2.

First, sew **O** and **J** 2 1/2" strips side by side. Make 5 strip sets. Press ALL strips sets toward **Fabric J**. Subcut 34 - 4 1/2" segments. Make 9 strip sets by sewing **N** and **J** 2 1/2" strips, subcut 68 - 4 1/2" segments. Make 5 strip sets by sewing **L** and **J** 2 1/2" strips, subcut 34 - 4 1/2" segments.



Next, draw a diagonal line on the backside of 68 **P** 2 1/2" squares. Draw a diagonal line on the backside of 68 **M** 2 1/2" squares.

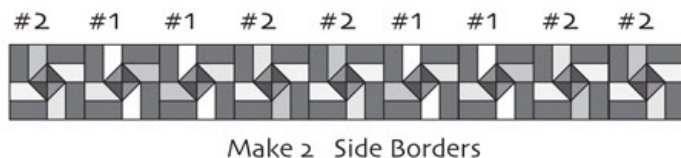
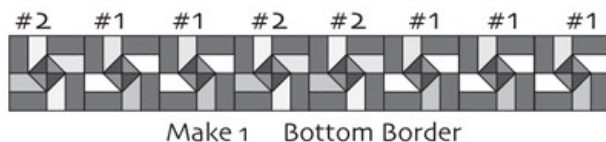
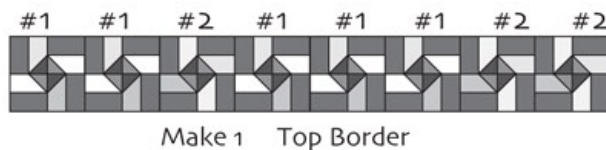
Place **P** or **M** square over the strip set corner, right sides together, according to the diagram. Stitch ON the diagonal line. Trim 1/4" from seam. Arrows indicate pressing directions. Make the following border units:

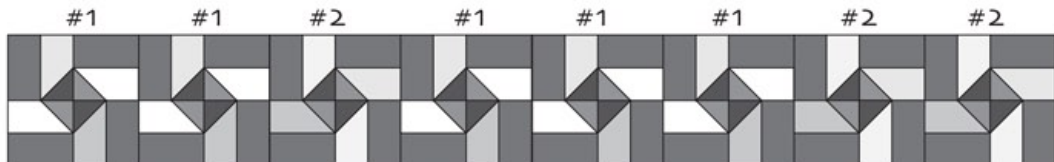


Sew Blocks #1 and #2 by sewing units together by rows according to the diagram.



7. Sew blocks in order according to the diagram. See cover picture for blocks orientation. Sew **SIDE** borders to the quilt first, then sew **TOP** and **BOTTOM** borders according to the diagram on the next page.



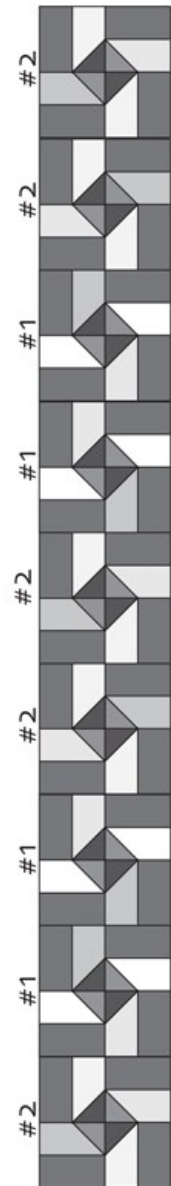

8. The quilt measures approximately 69" x 93". Make backing (**Fabric M**) at least 6" larger than the top. Baste together top, batting and backing. Quilt as desired. Attach binding (**Fabric P**) and enjoy!!

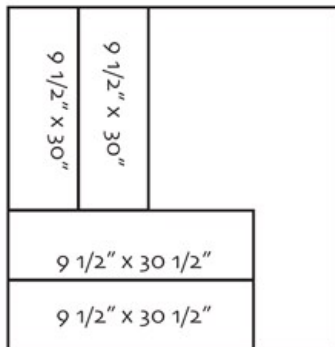
# Wall Hanging Instructions

## approximate size 49" x 48 1/2"

### Page 4

#### 1. Cut the following:

**Fabric A** - cut 2 - 9 1/2" x 30" and 2 - 9 1/2" x 30 1/2".  
Cut individual borders according to the diagram below.\*\*



**Fabric B** - cut 1 - 28 1/2" x 28 1/2"

**Fabric C** - cut 2 - 9 1/2" x 9 1/2" squares

**Fabric D** - cut 1 - 9 1/8" strip, subcut 2 - 9 1/8" x 5 1/4" rectangles. Cut rectangles in half diagonally according to the diagrams. (Fabric is directional so use only triangles with \*)



cut 2 - 5 3/8" x 5 3/8" squares, cut in half diagonally



cut 1 - 1 3/4" x 9 1/2"

**Fabric I** - cut 1 - 8 5/8" strip, cut 1 60° triangle  
(see cutting directions on page 1)

cut 1 - 6 7/8" square

**Fabric P** - cut 2 - 1 1/2" strips, subcut 2 - 1 1/2" x 28 1/2" (SIDES) and cut 2 - 1 1/4" strips, subcut 2 - 1 1/4" x 30 1/2" (TOP and BOTTOM)

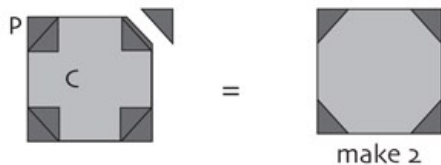
cut 1 - 3" strip, subcut 8 - 3" squares

**BINDING** - cut 6 - 2 1/4" strips, sew end to end and press in half

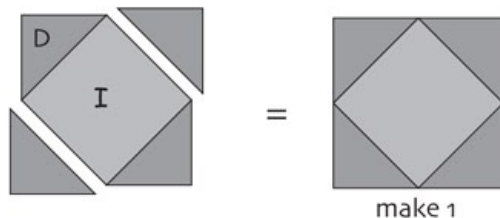
\*\*If **A** border measurements are slightly different, cut center square **B** with **P** borders to measure length of your fabric **A** pieces.

#### 2. Piecing Order:

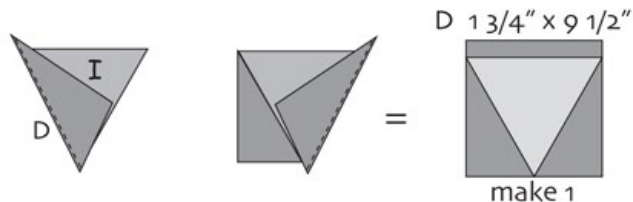
1. Draw a diagonal line on the backside of 8 **P** 3" squares. Place one square over each corner of 2 **C** 9 1/2" squares, right sides together. Stitch ON the diagonal line, trim 1/4" from seam. Press triangles outward.



2. Sew **D** triangles around one **I** 6 7/8" square, opposite sides first. Center triangles evenly.



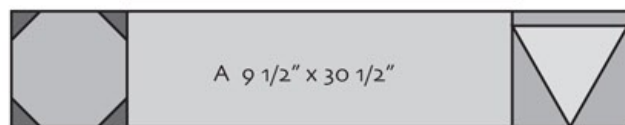
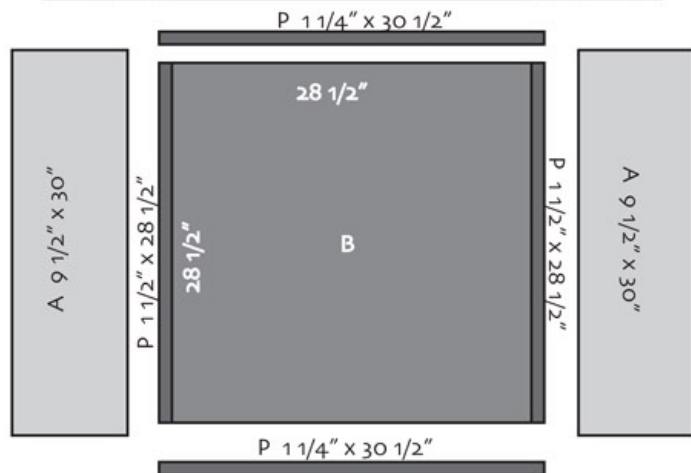
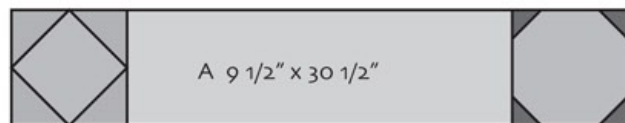
3. Sew **D** triangles to two sides of one **I** 60° triangle. Next, sew **D** 1 3/4" x 9 1/2" strip to the top of the block.



4. Sew **P** borders around center square **B**, SIDES first, then TOP and BOTTOM borders.

5. Sew blocks from step 1, 2, and 3 to both ends of **A** TOP and BOTTOM borders according to the diagram below.

6. Sew **A** borders to the quilt, SIDES first, then TOP and BOTTOM borders.



7. The quilt measures approximately 49" x 48 1/2". Make backing (**Fabric P**) at least 6" larger than top. Baste together top, batting and backing. Quilt as desired. Attach binding (**Fabric P**) and enjoy!!

# Pillow Instructions

approximate size 25 1/2" x 31 1/2"

## 1. Cut the following:

**Fabric A** - cut 1 - 9 1/2" x 20"

**Fabric E** - cut 2 - 3" x 11 1/2" (SIDES)

cut 2 - 5 1/4" x 27" (TOP and BOTTOM)

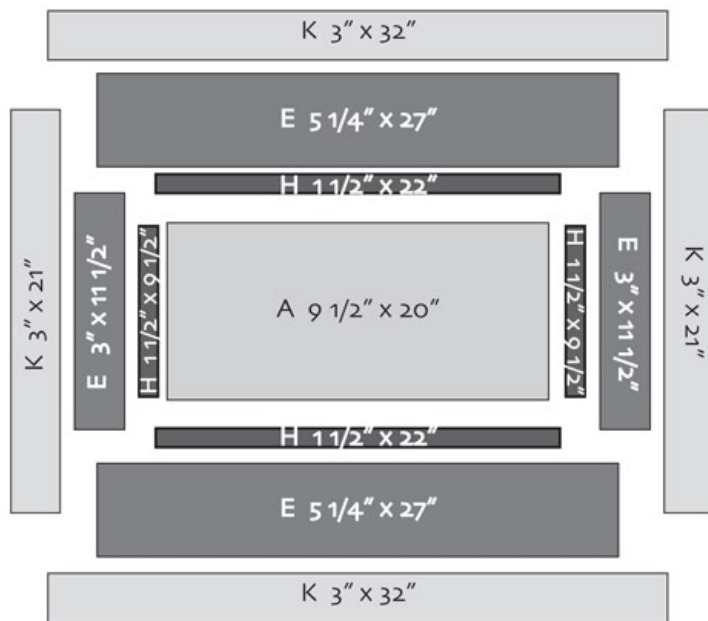
**Fabric H** - cut 2 - 1 1/2" strips, subcut 2 - 1 1/2" x 9 1/2" (SIDES) and 2 - 1 1/2" x 22" (TOP and BOTTOM)

**Fabric K** - cut 4 - 3" strips, subcut 2 - 3" x 21" (Sides) and 2 - 3" x 32" (TOP and BOTTOM)

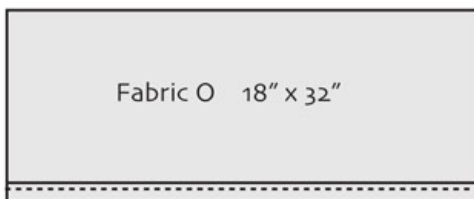
**Fabric O** - Backing - cut 2 - 18" x 32"

## 2. Piecing Order:

1. Sew individual **H**, **E**, **K** borders around center block **A**, SIDES first, then TOP and BOTTOM borders, according to the diagram.

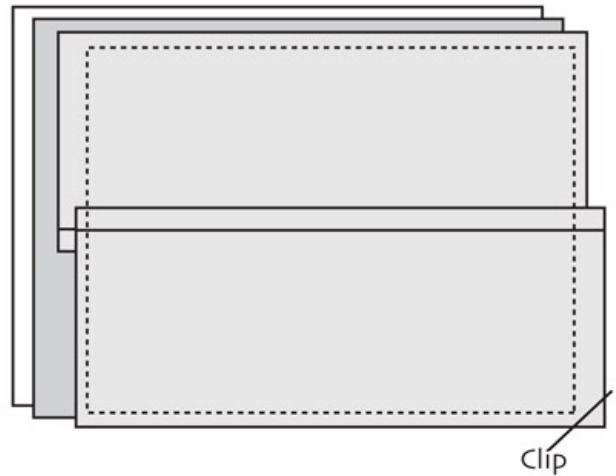


2. Double fold then topstitch one long side of both backing pieces.

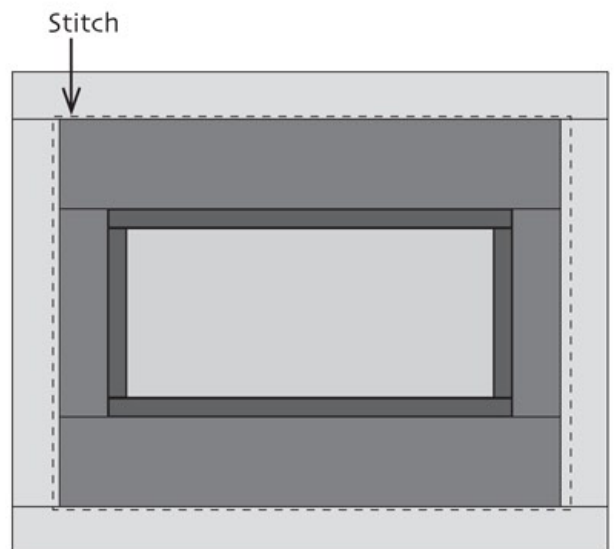

3. Layer batting, pillow top right side up, backing pieces right sides down. Match raw edges and pin together. Overlap backing pieces for opening. Stitch 1/4" around edge of pillow. Clip corners and turn pillow inside out.



4. Stitch in the ditch between **E** and **K** borders to create a flange. Insert standard pillow and enjoy!!

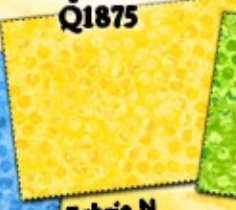

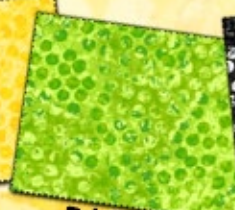
