Wine Country

Please read all instructions carefully before starting. All instructions include a 1/4" seam allowance and strips are cut from selvage to selvage unless otherwise stated.

Picnic Quilt Instructions approximate size 57" x 57"

1. Cut the following:

Fabric D - cut 3 - 9 1/2" strips, subcut 12 - 9 1/2" squares

Fabric F - cut 2 - 3 1/2" strips and 4 - 2" strips

Border - cut 6 - 2" strips, sew end to end for 1 long strip, then subcut 4 - 2" x 54 1/2"

Fabric G - cut 3 - 6 1/2" strips, fold and cut one strip in half. Use one and a half strips and subcut 26 - 2" x 6 1/2"

BINDING - cut 6 - 2 1/4" strips, sew end to end and press in half

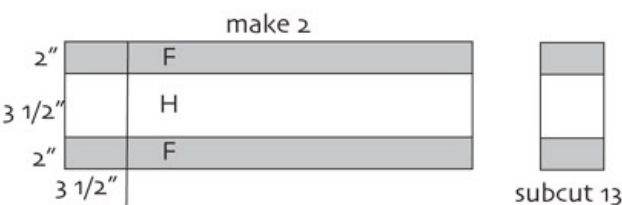
Fabric H - cut 2 - 3 1/2" strips

cut 11 - 2" strips. From 1 strip, subcut 10 - 2" squares

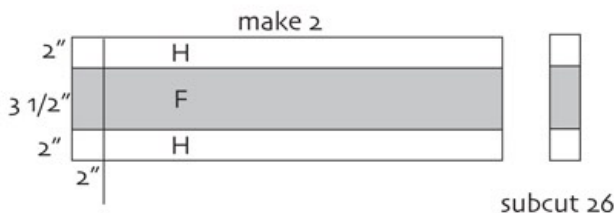
Fabric I - cut 3 - 9 1/2" strips. Fold and cut one strip in half, then from one and a half strips subcut 30 - 2" x 9 1/2"

2. Piecing Order:

1. First, make 2 strip sets by sewing **F, H, F** strips side by side according to the diagram. Press toward **F**. Subcut 13 - 3 1/2" segments.

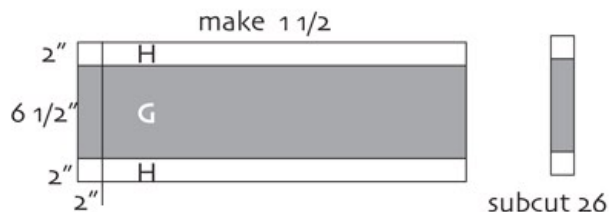


2. Next, make 2 strip sets by sewing **H, F, H** strips side by side according to the diagram. Press toward **F**. Subcut 26 - 2" segments.

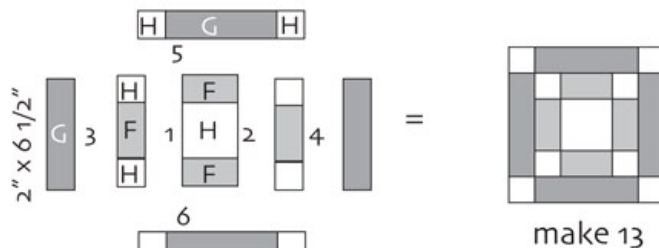


3. Fold and cut one **H** 2" strip in half. Make one and a half strip sets by sewing **H, G, H** strips side by side according to the diagram.

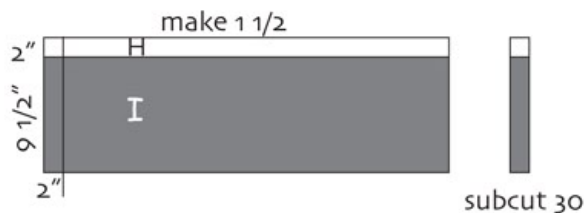
Press toward **G**. Subcut 26 - 2" segments.



4. Make 13 - 9" finished (9 1/2" unf.) Chain Blocks by sewing segments together according to the diagram.



5. **SASHING**: Make one and a half strip sets by sewing **J** 2" and **I** 9 1/2" strips. Press toward **I**. Subcut 30 - 2" segments.

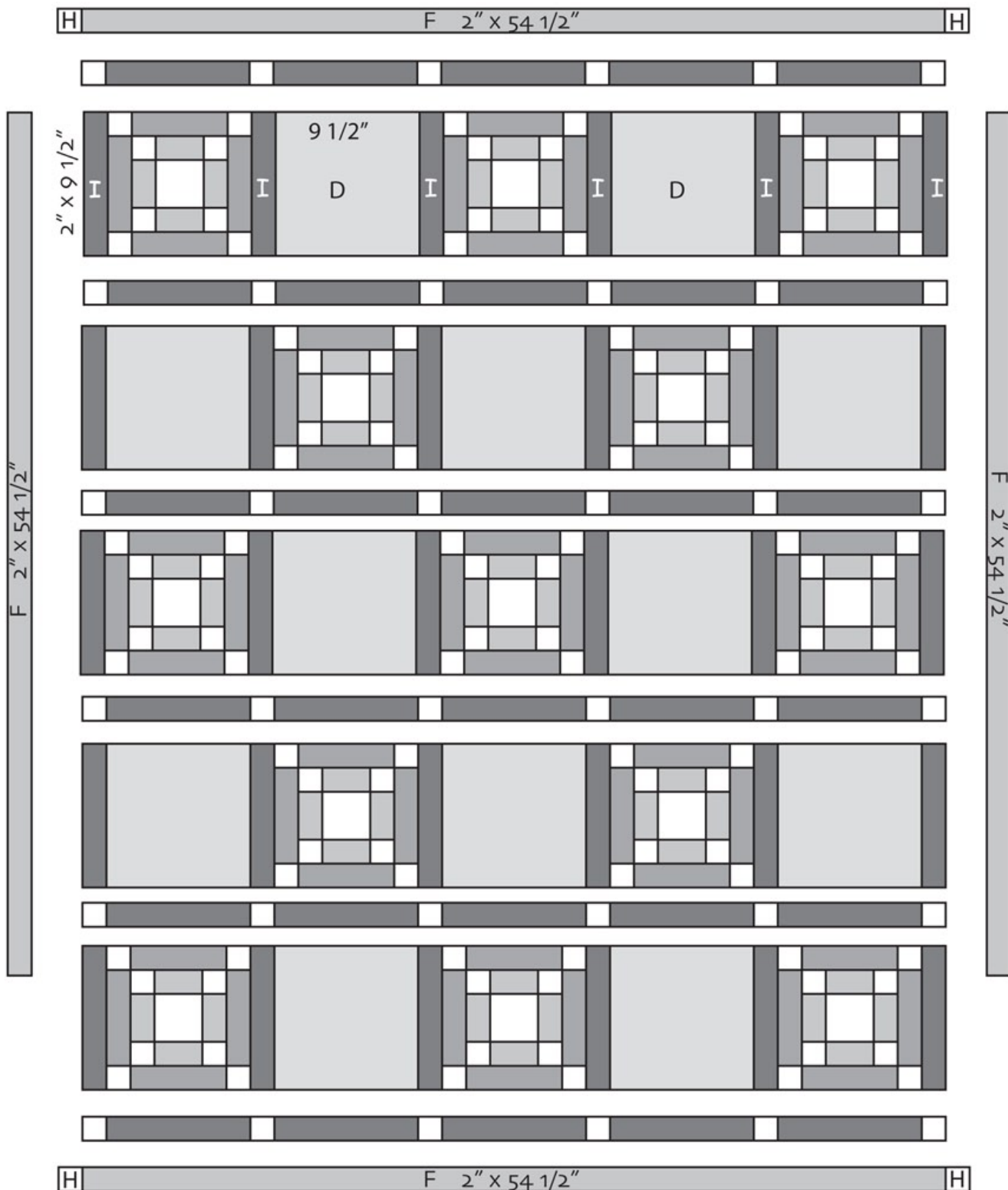


Next, sew 5 sashing segments together plus one **H** 2" square for 6 sashing rows. Press toward **I**.



6. Arrange blocks together by rows, alternating Chain blocks, **D** 9 1/2" squares and **I** 2" x 9 1/2" sashing strips according to the diagram. Sew rows of blocks and rows of sashing strips.

7. Sew **H** 2" squares to both ends of two **F** 2" x 54 1/2" borders for the TOP and BOTTOM borders. Sew SIDE borders to the quilt first, then sew TOP and BOTTOM borders according to the diagram.



8. The quilt measures approximately 57" x 57". Make backing (**Fabric J**) at least 6" larger than the top. Baste together top, batting and backing. Quilt as desired. Attach binding (**Fabric G**) and enjoy!!

Table Runner #1 Instructions

approximate size 20 3/4" x 65 1/2"

Page Three

1. Cut the following:

Fabric C - cut 2 - 14" x 14" squares, cut in half diagonally from both directions for 6 side triangles ☒

cut 2 - 7 1/4" x 7 1/4" squares, cut in half diagonally for 4 corner triangles ☒

Fabric E - cut 1 9 1/2" strip, subcut 4 - 9 1/2" squares

Fabric G - cut 5 - 2" strips, subcut 2 - 2" x 18 3/8". Sew 4 strips together end to end then subcut 2 - 2" x 62 7/8"

Fabric I - cut 8 - 2" strips, subcut 16 - 2" x 9 1/2" and 2 - 2" x 15 3/8". Sew three strips together end to end, then subcut 2 - 2" x 59 7/8"

Fabric K - cut 1 - 2" strip, subcut 11 - 2" squares

cut 1 - 3 3/8" strip, subcut 3 - 3 3/8" squares, cut in half diagonally from both directions for 10 cornerstone triangles. ☒

2. Piecing Order:

1. Sew table runner together by diagonal rows of blocks (E) and side triangles (C) alternating sashing strips (I) and cornerstones and triangles (K) according to the diagram.

2. First Border: Sew K 2" squares to both ends of two I 2" x 15 3/8" for the TOP and BOTTOM borders. Sew I 2" x 62 7/8" to the SIDES of the table runner. Next, sew top and bottom borders.

3. Outer Borders: sew K 2" squares to both ends of two G 2" x 18 3/8" for the TOP and BOTTOM borders. Sew G 2" x 62 7/8" to the SIDES of the table runner. Next, sew top and bottom borders according to the diagram.

4. Make backing (Fabric J) approximately 22" x 67" (slightly larger than table runner). Layer batting, backing (right side up), table runner (right side down). Pin layers together. Stitch 1/4" around edge of table runner, leaving approximately 10" opening for turning. Trim excess batting and clip corners. Turn right side out. Stitch opening closed. Quilt as desired and enjoy!!

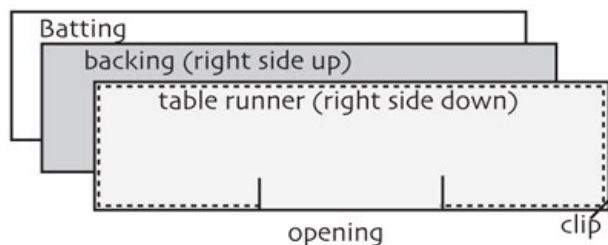
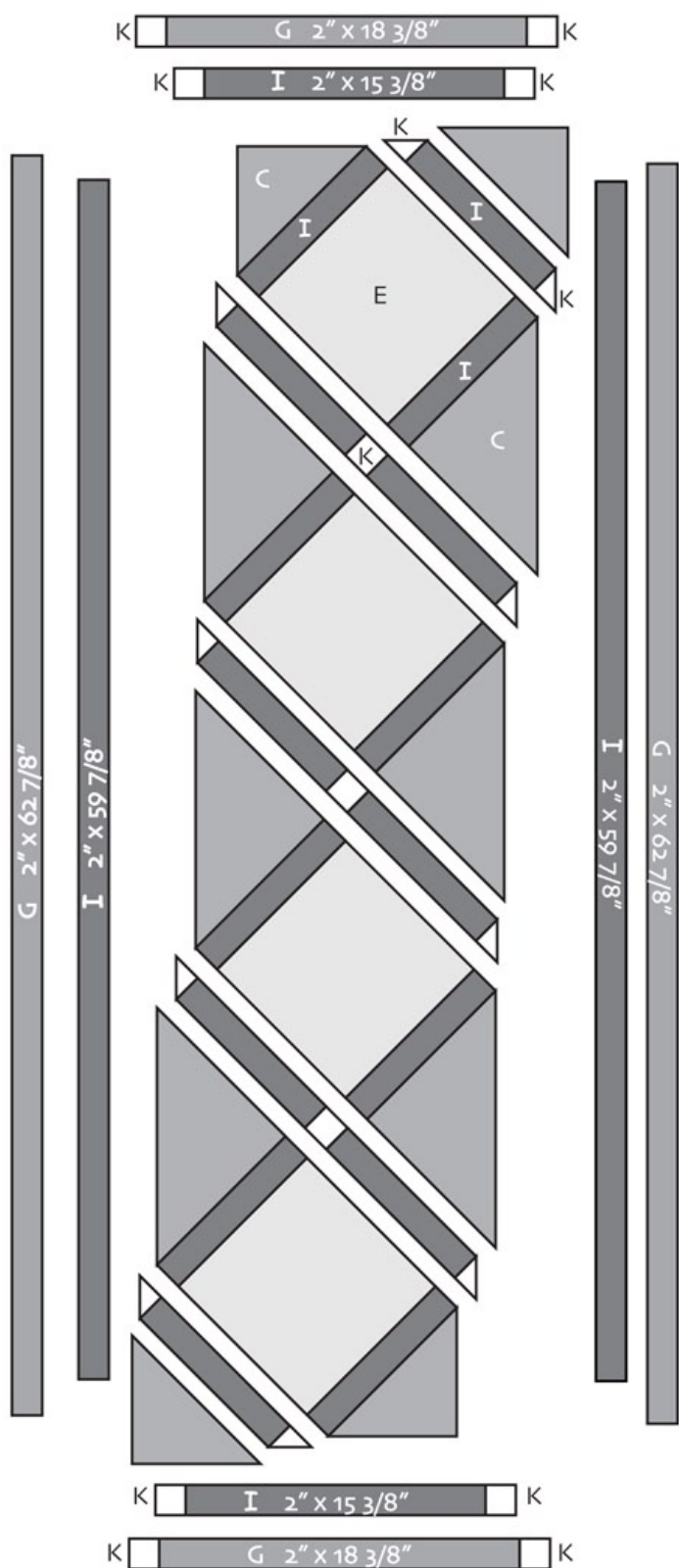


Table Runner #2 Instructions

approximate size 18 1/2" x 66"
Page Four

1. Cut the following:

Fabric A - cut lengthwise - 1 - 13" x 60 1/2"
(center designs evenly)

Fabric G - cut 5 - 2" strips, sew 4 strips end to end, then subcut 2 - 2" x 63 1/2". Subcut 2 - 2" x 16"

Fabric I - cut 5 - 2" strips, sew 4 strips end to end, then subcut 2 - 2" x 60 1/2". Subcut 2 - 2" x 13"

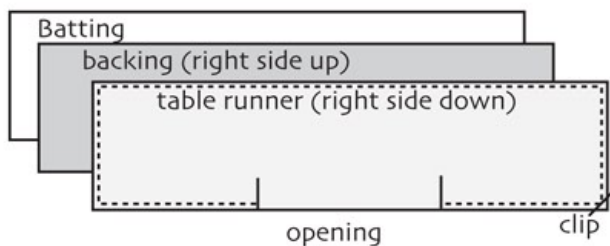
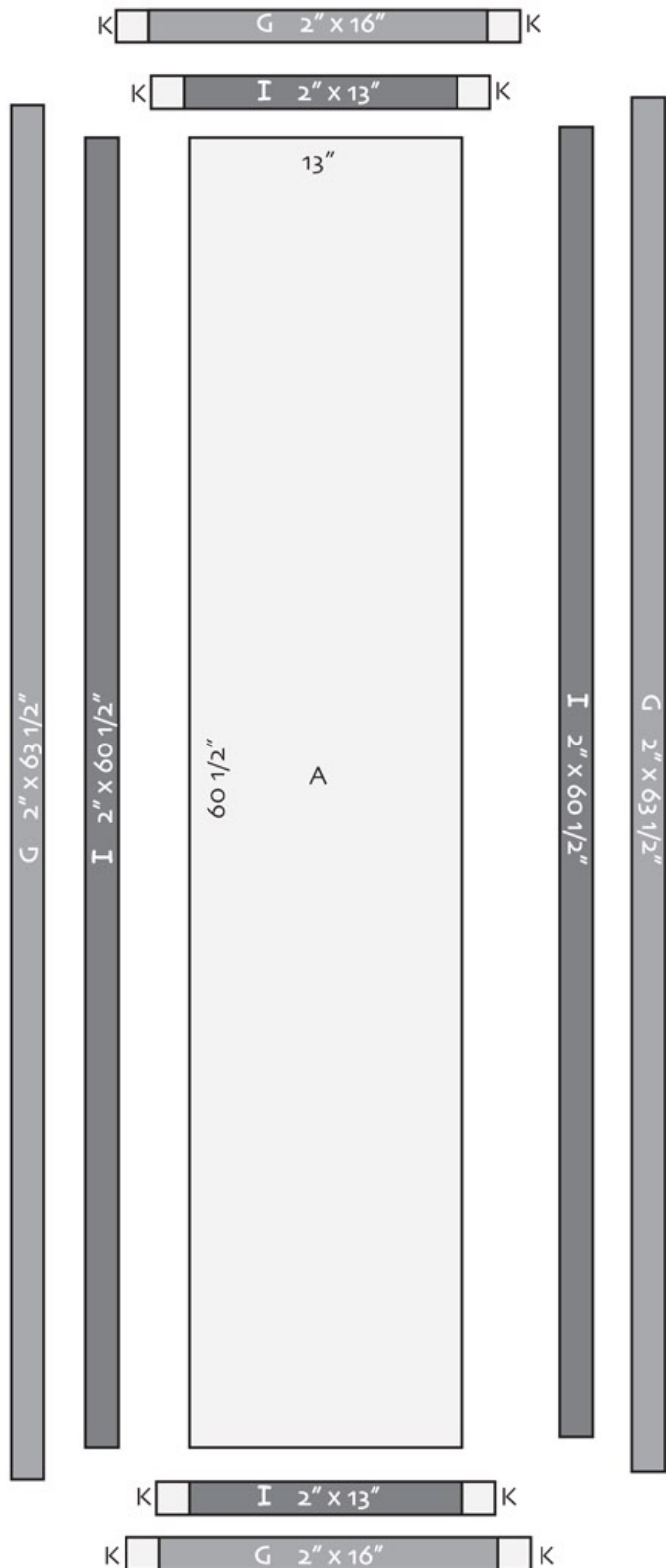
Fabric K - cut 1 - 2" strip, subcut 8 - 2" squares

2. Piecing Order:

1. Sew **K** 2" squares to both ends of two **I** 2" x 13" for TOP and BOTTOM borders. Sew **I** 2" x 60 1/2" to SIDES of **A**. Next, sew TOP and BOTTOM borders.

2. Sew **K** 2" squares to both ends of **G** 2" x 16" for the TOP and BOTTOM borders. Sew **G** 2" x 63 1/2" to the SIDES of the table runner. Next, sew TOP and BOTTOM borders.

3. Make backing (**Fabric J**) approximately 20" x 68" (slightly larger than table runner). Layer batting, backing (right side up), table runner (right side down). Pin layers together. Stitch 1/4" around edge of table runner, leaving approximately 10" opening for turning. Trim excess batting and clip corners. Turn right side out. Stitch opening closed. Quilt as desired and enjoy!!



Instructions for 4 Placemats:

approximate size 14" x 20"

Page Five

1. Cut the following:

Fabric B - cut 2 - 6 1/2" strips, subcut 12 - 6 1/2" squares

Fabric I - cut 1 - 2 1/2" strip

cut 4 - 1 1/2" strips

Borders - cut 8 - 1 1/2" strips, subcut 8 - 1 1/2" x 20 1/2" and 8 - 1 1/2" x 12 1/2"

Fabric J - BACKING - cut 4 - 14 1/2" x 20 1/2"

Fabric K - cut 1 - 2 1/2" strip

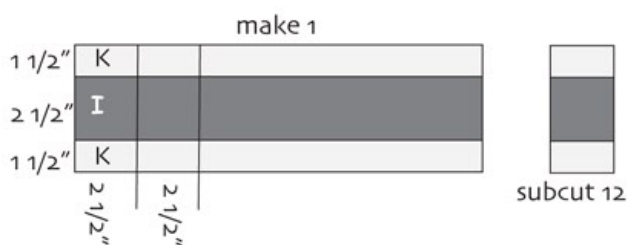
cut 2 - 4 1/2" strips. From 1 strip, subcut 24 - 1 1/2" x 4 1/2"

cut 2 - 1 1/2" strips

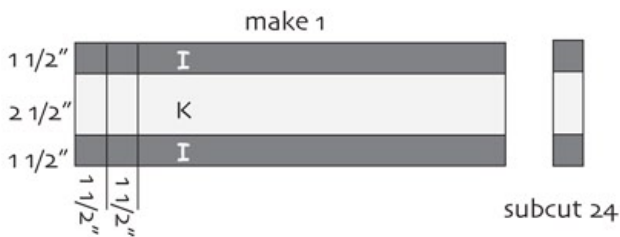
Thin Batting - cut 4 - 14 1/2" x 20 1/2"

2. Piecing Order:

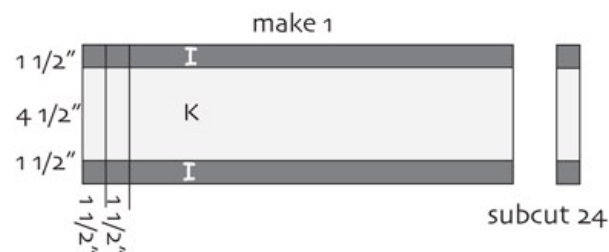
1. Make one strip set by sewing **K**, **I**, **K** strips side by side according to the diagram. Press toward **I**. Subcut 12 - 2 1/2" segments.



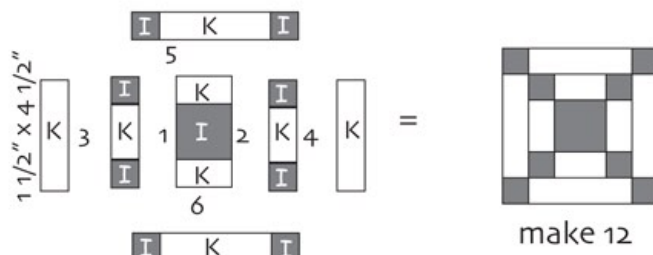
2. Make one strip set by sewing **I**, **K**, **I** strips side by side according to the diagram. Press toward **I**. Subcut 24 - 1 1/2" segments.



3. Make one strip set by sewing **I**, **K**, **I** strips side by side. Press toward **I**. Subcut 24 - 1 1/2" segments.

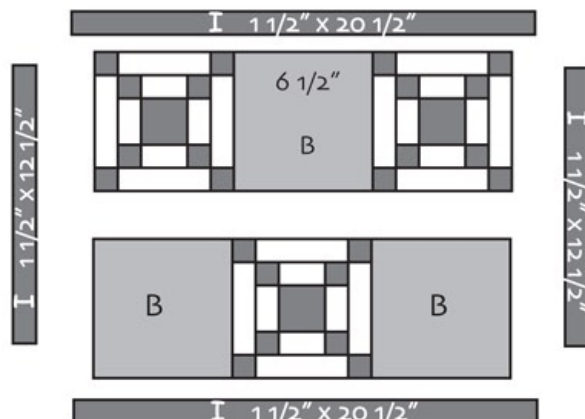


4. Make 12 - 6" finished (6 1/2" unf.) Chain Blocks by sewing segments together according to the diagram.



5. Sew placemats together by rows alternating Chain Blocks and **B** 6 1/2" squares according to the diagram.

Next, sew **I** borders around placemats, **SIDES** first, then **TOP** and **BOTTOM** borders. Repeat for all 4 placemats.



6. Layer batting, backing (right side up), placemat (right side down). Match edges and pin layers together. Stitch 1/4" around placemat, leaving approximately 7" opening for turning. Clip corners and any excess batting. Turn placemat right sides out. Stitch opening closed. Quilt as desired and enjoy!!
